Fred Talk routine

- 1. Say the word in sounds as Fred e.g. c-a-t.
- 2. Ask your child to repeat. Can they 'jump-in' with the whole word?
- 3. Say the word in sounds followed by the whole word e.g. c-a-t, cat
- 4. Ask your child to repeat

What can I do to help?

- Talk to our child about the new sounds they are learning.
- Read your child's Reading for Pleasure book with them.
- Help your child sound out the letters in words and blend them together to make a whole word. Try to not refer to the letters by their names.
- Encourage your child to tell you the story out loud; ask them questions about things that happen or what they think about some of the characters in the story.
