Computer	An electronic device that has a screen, a keyboard, and a mouse to control it
Connected	Two or more things are joined or linked together
Headphones	A pair of small speakers that you wear over your ears to listen to sounds or music from a computer or other electronic devices.
Keyboard	A set of buttons or keys that you press with your fingers to type letters, numbers, and symbols into a computer or other electronic devices.
Monitor	A screen that displays information from a computer
Online	Being connected to or accessed via the internet
Printer	A machine that prints documents or images from a computer onto paper
Technology	Any tools or devices that people use to make or do things
