The school will continue to monitor its designated Covid-19 email address (covid19@banksroad.liverpool.sch.uk) until Sunday 20th December at 3:30pm.

We ask parents to inform school up until Sunday 20th December at 3:30pm if their child:

- develops Covid-19 symptoms (new persistent cough/high temperature/loss of taste or smell)
- has taken a test and is waiting for results
- has tested positive

Please do not delay in informing school.

This will allow school to work with families to contact track and trace where necessary leading up to Christmas.

If your child develops symptoms or takes a test in which they are positive after the 20th December at 3:30pm, you do not need to inform school.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank the staff of our school for the herculean effort throughout this term to keep our school open. It has been, in every sense, a real team effort by the whole school community and I am immensely proud of what we have achieved in the most challenging of circumstances.

I would also like to thank all parents and carers for your support over this past term, and wish all our families a happy Christmas. We look forward to welcoming the children back to school on Wednesday 6th January 2021. We request that all children are in school by no later than 08:55am.
