A River—Medium Term Plan

Year: 2

Topic: Digital Media (Photography)

Term: Autumn 1

Lesson	Focus
1	Unplugged—look at a range of random photos (some good, some bad (i.e. out of focus, things cut out etc.) What's good about these photos? Why are some not as good? What has gone wrong?
2	Children spend some time taking photographs around the class/school grounds. Allow children to make mistakes and get used to using the camera.
3	Introduce children to the editing tool. Exposure/Brightness/Filters/Cropping/Rotating etc. Allow children to have a play but justify their choices.
4	Class to travel down to the River Mersey to take photographs. Consider all of the things discussed over the past few weeks. (Focus, light, shadow, cutting things out etc.)
5	Editing and adding filters to the photographs previously taken.
6	Reviewing and evaluating photographs. What do you like about your photo? What would you do differently next time? Is there a particular feature you're proud of?
